

**RHYTHM NATION DANCE ACADEMY**  
~ RULES AND REGULATIONS ~

**I UNDERSTAND:**

1. that tuition is due according to the payment schedule. If tuition is not paid as agreed, then a **\$10.00 late fee will be assessed**. If my account is delinquent for more than one session, I understand that my child will not be able to attend class until my account is paid accordingly.
  
2. that I will be responsible for the full tuition of my child. I understand that **no refunds or credits** will be given for missed classes. If an illness or scheduled vacation requires an absence, I will alert the instructor immediately.
  
3. that **all registration, tuition, recital fees and late fees must be paid in full no later April 2, 2016** or your child **will not** be able to participate in the Spring Dance Recital.
  
4. that Rhythm Nation Dance Academy **reserves the right to drop registrants** from the class for:
  - a) excessive lateness and/or absence;
  - b) disruptive behavior;
  - c) non-payment of tuition or other fees;
  
5. that in the event of an accident or illness involving my child, I will be notified immediately. In the event I cannot be contacted, I hereby authorize Rhythm Nation Dance Academy and/or the City of Plantation to take steps deemed necessary to make medical attention available. Medical attention includes physician, hospitals, or any other medical services that Rhythm Nation Dance Academy and/or the City of Plantation considers immediate. I also understand that **all medical expenses incurred will be at my expense**.
  
6. that any limitations in ability to participate due to a **medical condition must be noted on the child's registration form** as "Health Information". Failure to note such conditions is a warranty by the parent that such conditions do not exist.
  
7. I hereby acknowledge that I am aware of the nature of instruction that my child will receive and that such instruction involves physical exercise and stress which could result in injury. It is further agreed that unless caused by the negligence of the instructor or staff, I hereby **waive all claims and do not hold Rhythm Nation Dance Academy and/or its instructors or staff responsible** for any such injury incurred during the course of instruction or while waiting to be picked up.
  
8. that Rhythm Nation Dance Academy does not allow any student of any age to leave the facility without an adult. Parents are expected to pick-up their child immediately after class, unless prior arrangements were discussed and approved by the instructor.

9. that Rhythm Nation Dance Academy and/or the City of Plantation reserves the right to alter class schedules, for any reason (either temporary or permanently), without fault.

10. that Rhythm Nation Dance Academy does have a dress code for its students and that they must wear the **required attire**: black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes and black jazz shoes. Accessories such as but not limited to necklaces, bracelets, rings or dangling earrings are not allowed and should not be brought to class.

### ~CLASS RULES~

#### ALL STUDENTS:

1. must attend class in the proper attire. **Proper Attire:** Black Leotard, Pink Tights, Pink Ballet Shoes and Black Jazz Shoes.
2. are only allowed to **bring a small snack** (ie. cookies, chips, crackers, grapes, carrots), bottled water and/or sip-up drink (ie. Caprisun, Hi-C, Juicy Juice) to class. Snacks can only be consumed during class if approved by the instructor.
3. must **display a positive attitude and behavior**. Excessive talking, foul language, and/or disrespectful behavior to fellow students, instructors, or staff will NOT be tolerated. Any student demonstrating unacceptable behavior will not be allowed to participate in the class.
4. must **attend class on time** and if they are more than 10 minutes late, they may not be able to participate for the remainder of that discipline. A late student can enter the class, but may be asked by the instructor to sit and watch the remainder of the class. If a student is late more than 3 times, they may be withdrawn from the class by the instructor/staff.
5. must understand that **class attendance is very important** and if they need to miss a class, the responsible parent should notify the staff in advance. If a student is absent for more than 3 times without notice, they may be subject to withdrawal by the instructor/staff.
